Subject: Fields Ertel Corridor Improvement Study | Notification of Field Work

Dear Property Owner,

The Hamilton County and Warren County Engineers, in conjunction with the City of Sharonville, Deerfield Township, Symmes Township and Sycamore Township, intend to study Fields Ertel Road between Reed Hartman Highway and Wilkens Boulevard (near the I-71 interchange) to investigate ways to provide a safer roadway to better serve the needs of the public. This work includes documenting existing conditions, such as traffic flow, sight distance restrictions, safety hazards and environmental resources. KZF Design is performing this work under contract to the Hamilton County Engineer.

To complete the necessary survey work, traffic analyses and environmental investigations, it may be necessary for work crews to enter upon your property in the next few months to obtain certain field data needed in connection with the study. This entry is authorized by Section 5517.01 and 163.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, which also requires reimbursement be made for any actual damage resulting from such work. The crews have received strict instructions concerning the preservation of private property and public lands, however if at any time you feel that our representatives have not given proper attention to your private property, please notify us at once.
