Deerfield puts brakes on Fields Ertel development

Deerfield Township trustees on Tuesday adopted a moratorium of at least one year on development in the Fields Ertel Road corridor, the Hamilton Journal-News reported.

The moratorium will allow the township to finish a comprehensive plan for the area, where retail, office and residential development has mushroomed, sometimes haphazardly, over the past two decades.

Projects that have already been approved are not subject to the moratorium. That includes land on Fields Ertel between Wilkens and Snider roads that just was just rezoned for residential use, where a 350-unit development is planned, the newspaper reported.

The moratorium covers development with 1,000 feet of Fields Ertel from Butler-Warren Road to the Little Miami River, the Journal-News said.
