Survey work to start on Fields Ertel

ENQUIRER STAFF REPORT

The infamous traffic problems near the Fields Ertel Road interchange with Interstate 71 are about to get a closer look from local engineers.

During the next few months, study crews from KZF Design will be working along Fields Ertel Road between Reed Hartman Highway and Wilkens Boulevard. Their work will include documenting existing conditions, such as traffic flow, sight distance restrictions, and safety hazards.

The study of Fields Ertel Road involves several local agencies and governments including the Warren County and Hamilton County engineers offices, Deerfield Township, the City of Sharonville, Symmes Township and Sycamore Township.

Officials say some of the survey work will require access to private properties; reimbursement for damages, should any occur, is required by state law.
